Health guarantee:

Precious Puppies Puppy Kennel hereby guarantees that all puppies purchased shall come with records verifying the vaccinations, treatments, etc. which have been administered to the puppy up to the time of puppy transfer to the buyer, after which time it is the buyer's responsibility to continue treatments and/or assessments by a veterinarian of their choice at their expense. If the puppy purchased should be found by a licensed veterinarian of the buyer's choosing and at the buyer's expense within 10 days of the puppy's transfer date to the buyer to have any pre-existing or disease issues including the following conditions: heartworm parasites (*dirofilaria immitis*), or genetic health defects such as enlarged heart or hernia, or diseases of canine distemper, canine adenovirus type 1 and 2, parainfluenza, parvovirus, *leptospira canicola*, and/or *L. Icterohaemorrhagiae* which may result in illness or death of the puppy (Note: this does NOT include common diarrhea, stomach or intestinal worms or parasites such as coccidia or giardia, and otherwise accidental injury or death – see below*) then, at the buyer's request, Precious Puppies Puppy Kennel will refund the buyer of the puppy the full purchase price upon the return of the puppy to Precious Puppies Puppy Kennel provided the following conditions have been met:

The buyer contacts Precious Puppies Puppy Kennel (Managers: Paul and Bonnie Crum) by phone at 662-284-6991 and/or by email at paulcrum829@gmail.com within 24 hours of their veterinarian's examination and also returns the puppy within 48 hours to Precious Puppies Puppy Kennel with a signed verification of such findings by the licensed veterinarian whose business location and contact information is provided on the verification; and at the discretion of Precious Puppies Puppy Kennel, another licensed veterinarian also concurs with the findings from the buyer's veterinarian exam.

Note: Any costs or fees associated with the buyer's veterinarian examination or treatment shall be the sole responsibility of the buyer. Any costs or fees associated with Precious Puppies Puppy Kennel veterinarian examination or treatment shall be the sole responsibility of Precious Puppies Puppy Kennel. Precious Puppies Puppy Kennel does not assume responsibility for any expenses incurred by the buyer such as transportation costs or any associated veterinarian expenses related to such occurrences. If this puppy is found to have any pre-existing or disease related health issues by a licensed veterinarian (at the buyer's expense) to occur within 10 days of purchase, the buyer may choose to return it to us at that time for a refund of the purchase price. We cannot however be responsible for vet bills or other bills that might be incurred following the transfer of the puppy to the buyer.

**It should be noted that puppies sometimes have diarrhea or reduced appetites when transitioning to a new environment or travel due to several different reasons. The buyer must monitor the puppy to ensure that it is eating well and drinking plenty of water so that it does not become dehydrated or malnourished. It is also quite common for puppies to have intestinal worms and/or parasites such as coccidia or giardia even after initial treatments are given at early stages. It is imperative that the buyer have their puppy vet checked and continue to follow recommended schedules for vaccinations and/or treatments due to potential harm that may occur if left untreated. Puppies also may have sudden drops in blood-sugar levels which may result in lethargic behavior and even convulsions or seizures which may have a very rapid onset of symptoms. During a minimum of the 10 days following transfer of the puppy and for as long as necessary, the new owner should monitor the puppy continuously and provide regular meals and sugar intake such as small amounts of syrup or natural sugars to ensure that proper nutrition and blood-sugar levels are maintained. If an event as described above should occur, immediately rub syrup or a nutritional calorie supplement on the puppy's gums and into its mouth. Note: Products containing chocolate or caffeine should NOT be given to dogs. It is the buyer's responsibility to monitor the puppy at all times to guard against such events or other accidental injuries, and Precious Puppies Puppy Kennel does not assume responsibility for injury or death to the puppy should such events beyond our control occur after the puppy is transferred to the buyer. Should such events occur, veterinarian consultation and/or treatment is left to the discretion and financial responsibility of the buyer. Precious puppies will not take responsibility for veterinarian bills or issue a purchase refund in the event of sickness, injury, or death of the puppy due to circumstances which are beyond our control once the puppy has left our care.
